

Application Requirements


DVR RECORDS requires a smart phone or tablet , an internet connection, and also a Google account for identity and access management purposes. This allows us to better protect your data. It's important that the Google account you use is not a personal account. You'll want to create a new Google Account with an existing email address where you would like to have your forensic reports sent. ie John.Smith@NYPD.gov Below you find the steps to create a google account for your existing work email.

1.) Sign out of any currently logged in Google Accounts.

2.) Navigate to the below link.
